

The EASS Saturday Centre provides a wide range of music opportunities for children who live and/or attend school in the London Borough of Enfield. Guided by our team of experienced music tutors, pupils develop their knowledge, skills and understanding in music in a relaxed and friendly environment.

SATURDAY STRINGS

9.10am-10.10am

A mixed string ensemble for pupils who are learning **violin, viola, 'cello** or **double bass**. The group is open to pupils who have had a minimum of two terms of tuition. Saturday Strings is led by a string specialist tutor and the ensemble plays a variety of music, both classical and popular.

SATURDAY KEYBOARD CLUB 09.15am-10.15am
11.30am-12.30pm

For pupils who have had a minimum of 2 terms of keyboard lessons. Pupils will learn a variety of music and perform together as a group. Pupils must bring their own electronic keyboard (with batteries).

MUSIC THEORY CLASSES 10.20am-10.50am
12.00-12.30pm

Beginner/Intermediate classes, preparing pupils for ABRSM Music Theory examinations up to Grade 5.

SATURDAY MUSIC CLUB 09.15am-10.00am

This club for school years 1 and 2 pupils is led by a primary school specialist. Pupils listen, sing and play hand-held and tuned percussion instruments (e.g. tambourines, xylophones) and move to music. The Music Club provides an excellent foundation for learning to play an instrument later on.

SATURDAY SINGERS 10.20am-11.20am

A choir for primary school pupils in school years 3 to 6 with fun sessions which will develop children's vocal skills. They sing songs in a wide variety of styles including pop, jazz, musicals, folk songs from around the world, songs in parts and much more...!

END-OF-TERM CONCERTS

All Saturday Centre music groups (except theory students) have opportunities to perform to an audience of family and friends at the end of each term. These concerts also include solos by some of the Saturday Centre pupils who are having individual instrumental lessons.

LEARN TO PLAY A MUSICAL INSTRUMENT

Instrumental lessons currently offered at the Saturday Centre include keyboard, piano, woodwind and string instruments plus guitar, drum kit and tabla. Lessons are provided subject to the availability of accommodation and tutors. Application forms for instrumental lessons are available on request from the EASS office.

EASS also offers after-school weekday music activities at Enfield County Lower School and Houndsfield and Churchfield primary schools. Details are available on request from the EASS office.
